Getting Started

1. Access Auto Repair Reference Center through your local public library's website (look for the **eRESOURCES A - Z** button)

OR

through the library's online catalogue at www.tracpac.ab.ca (look for the **eRESOURCES** link then choose **DO IT YOURSELF**)

2. Verify your library membership by entering your library card barcode number and library PIN (if you do not know your library PIN, please contact you library)

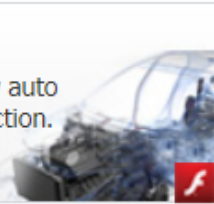
