


## What is lynda.com?


lynda.com is an online library of training videos to help you learn the latest software, creative, and business skills. lynda.com allows you to learn what you want, when you want, at your own pace!

## Getting started

For your first visit, access lynda.com through your local Public Library's website or through [www.marigold.ab.ca/eresources](http://www.marigold.ab.ca/eresources). Locate the link to lynda.com and click on it. You will be asked to verify your library membership by entering your library card barcode number and PIN (if you do not know your library PIN, please contact your library).



At the Welcome screen, click on No, I've never had an account



Create your new lynda.com profile by filling in your name and email address.


## Using lynda.com

Once you have created your lynda.com account, you will now be able to login at any time by visiting [www.lynda.com](http://www.lynda.com).

Click on the Log in link at the top right of the page.

Choose Organization Login.

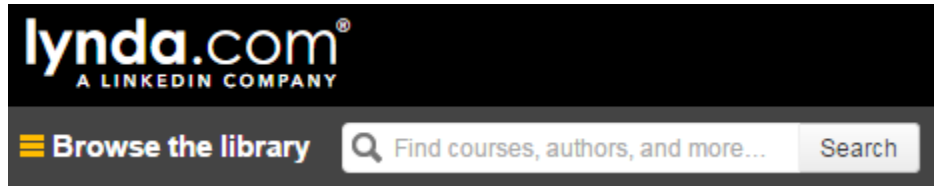
Choose to log in through Marigold Library System (click on the blue Go button).



You will now be able to log in with your library card barcode number and PIN.

## Find courses

## FAQs

*Can I use the lynda.com mobile apps?*

Not at this time. The lynda.com mobile apps are currently not available with the library subscription.

*Who teaches the lynda.com courses?*

The courses are all taught by recognized industry experts.

*What kind of bandwidth do the videos require?*

The minimum requirement is 2Mbps, but 3Mbps or higher is recommended.
