

Ozobots



These adorable robots are programmed through colour, making them a great tool for teaching coding concepts to people of all ages, no coding experience required! Sign up for a free Ozobot Classroom account for access to hundreds of lesson and activity plans.

This kit includes 18 bots, markers, a quick start guide, rulers, and color code charts. Also included is a magnet board and 36 colour code magnets, designed to assist younger participants or those who need assistance with drawing thick, straight lines.

GamerSpaces



Marigold staff have created two mobile GamerSpaces. These video game kits are designed for local multiplayer gaming. Each kit comes equipped with all the cords and adaptors needed to connect the system to a library-provided monitor, TV, or projector, as well as step by step set-up instructions.

Both systems come already equipped with a downloaded library of digital games from a variety of genres. Please note that games with various ratings are included. Nintendo Switch GamerSpace

This GamerSpace features a Nintendo Switch and can accommodate up to 6 players at a time. Included are 4 extra joy cons and optional grips. Players can choose from a library of digital multiplayer games including Mario Kart, Just Dance, Switch Sports, Overcooked, and much more!

Steam Deck GamerSpace




This GamerSpace features a Steam
