What is Solaro?

Solaro is an online tool developed by the creators of the KEY Study Guides. Solaro provides study help and exam preparation for Mathematics, English Language Arts, and Science for grades 3-12 and Social Studies for grades 6 and 9-12.

Accessing & Searching

Logging On

1. Visit the library website and select **eResources**.
2. Select **Solaro**.
3. Login with your **library card barcode number** and **PIN number** (if you do not know your **PIN number**, contact your local library).
4. If you are a first time user, enter your **library card barcode number** and click **Request**. Solaro will generate a log in for you.
5. Once you receive your username and password, click on **www.solaro.com**.
6. Enter your username and password and click **Log in**.
7. You can now also use this username and password to log into the Solaro app.

Adding Courses

1. Click **Add Course**.
2. Select your **Region** (Alberta) and **Grade**. Click **Update**.
3. Select all the classes you would like to add.

Parents

Parents can monitor their children's progress through the Solaro Parent Interface. Students must send parents an invitation in order to access the Solaro Parent Interface.

1. Click on the profile tab in the top right corner and select **My Account**.
2. Under **Invite Parent**, click **Add** and enter an email address. Click **Save**.
3. Parents should receive an invite in their email.
